Notice of Race

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as determined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.

Equipment is required to conform to the rules of the IM17CA.

2. Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry

The Regatta is open to all boats of the Melges 17 class. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form by April 21st or at the time of registration.

4. Fees

The required fees are as follows. \$150.00 Checks (made out to Lake Geneva Yacht Club) or credit cards are acceptable forms of payment.

Entry fee includes: Friday Snacks, Continental Breakfasts, Saturday Lunch and Dinner and Sunday Lunch, Launching and top notch Racing.

Additional Lunches for Saturday can be purchased for \$10.00 per person.

Additional Dinners can be purchased for \$25.00 per person.

Additional Lunches for Sunday can be purchased for \$13.00 per person.

5. Schedule

Registration: Friday, May 7th, 2009 from 6-8 PM and May 8th from 8-9 AM.
Dates of Racing: Saturday May 9th and Sunday May 9th, 2010.
The scheduled time of Warning Signal for the First Race is 10:30AM.
No Warning Signal will be made after 1:30 PM Sunday May 9th.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration or on line at the official class website: www.melges17.com

7. Venue

The Lake Geneva Yacht Club is located at 1250 South Lake Shore Drive, Fontana, WI. 53125 The racing area is the West end of Lake Geneva.

8. Courses

The Courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward with the discretion to finish downwind.

9. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System described in appendix "A" of the RRS will apply, except a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. No more than six races will be held.

10. Radio Communications

A boat will neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to cellular telephones.

11. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows: Top 5. Special Awards will also be included.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race
The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

Competitors will be required to wear Coast Guard Approved Life Jackets while on the water.
